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### **RESIDENTIAL CARE GIVER TRAINING ACT**

*(Assented to , 1990)*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Definitions

**1 In this Act:**

(a) "educational institution" means an institution recognized by the Canadian Association of Community Colleges or the Canadian Association of Universities and Colleges;

(b) "Minister" means the Minister of Family and Social Services;

(c) "residential care giver" means an individual providing services in a residence which include personal care, health care and home care to a person with physical or mental disabilities to enable that person to live independently and includes an individual designated as a personal care attendant, residential care giver or home care attendant;

(d) "required training" means training of individuals to be residential care givers prescribed by the Minister pursuant to section 4 and carried out at an educational institution.

**2(1)** No individual shall render the services of residential care giver for reward without having completed the required training.

**(2)** No person shall employ or contract for the services of a residential care giver unless the care giver has completed the required training.

- Council      **3(1)** There shall be an Alberta Personal Care Advisory Council consisting of those members appointed by the Minister.
- (2)** The Council shall include individuals experienced in health care and social care.
- (3)** The Council shall advise the Minister on matters relating to personal care and the services of residential care givers.
- (4)** The members of the Council may receive such fees and reimbursement of expenses as is authorized by Order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, out of money appropriated to that purpose by the Legislature.
- Training standards      **4** The Minister may prescribe the required training by regulation after consultation with the Council.
- Crown bound            **5** The Crown is bound by this Act.
- Coming into force      **6** Section 2 commences on July 1, 1992.
