AN ACT TO AMEND THE ALBERTA HEALTH CARE INSURANCE ACT

(Assented to , 1990)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Alberta Health Care Insurance Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 1(n) is amended by adding the following after (i):

(i.1) counselling and treatment services provided to a person who has been determined by a court, in criminal or civil proceedings, to have been a victim or a perpetrator of family violence, when the services are provided by a person having the qualifications specified in the regulations.

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter A-21 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980.

2 Section 1.(n) presently reads as follows:

(n) *"insured services" means*

(i) *all services provided by physicians that are medically required,*

(ii) *those services that are provided by a dental surgeon in the field of oral surgery and are specified in the regulations, and*

(iii) *any other services that are declared to be insured services pursuant to section 2,*

but does not include any services that a person is eligible for and entitled to under any Act of the Parliament of Canada or under the Workers' Compensation Act or any law of any jurisdiction outside Alberta relating to workers' compensation.
