THE CALGARY JEWISH ACADEMY AMENDMENT ACT, 1990

(Assented to

, 1990)

WHEREAS the Calgary Hebrew School was incorporated by an Act to incorporate the Calgary Hebrew School, being chapter 83 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927; and

WHEREAS an Act to incorporate the Calgary Hebrew School was amended by chapter 75 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1963, and by chapter 47 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1987, which Act changed the name of The Calgary Hebrew School Act to The Calgary Jewish Academy Act; and

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that it being enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Calgary Jewish Academy Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 4(a) is amended to read:
 - 4(a) As at January 1, 1963, any property owned or leased by The Calgary Jewish Academy shall be exempt from assessment and taxation so long as the same is used for educational or religious purposes, or ancillary to the operation of a school used for such purposes, and except for local improvement taxes and taxes pertaining to minerals.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend Chapter 83 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927.
- 2 Section 4(a) presently reads as follows:

As at the first day of January, 1963, the following property, namely:

The west 247.5 feet of lot 2, in block A, according to a plan of part of the City of Calgary of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Calgary 1790 A.M.;

shall be exempt from assessment and taxation so long as the same is used for educational or religious purposes except for local improvement taxes and taxes pertaining to minerals.
