TURNER VALLEY UNIT OPERATIONS AMENDMENT ACT, 1991

(Assented to

, 1991)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Turner Valley Unit Operations Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 5 is repealed and the following is substituted:
 - 5 The Board may amend a unit operation order on its own motion or on the application of an interested person.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter T-12 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 5 presently reads:
 - 5(1) A unit operation order may provide for a rehearing by the Board on the application of any interested person or after a future date specified in the order.
 - (2) When a unit operation order has been made and whether or not the order provides for a rehearing, the Board, on its own motion, may hold a rehearing when in its opinion the circumstances so warrant.
 - (3) Following the rehearing, the Board may amend or revise a unit operation order in order to supply any deficiency therein or to meet changing conditions, and may alter or revoke any provision that is considered by the Board to be unfair or inequitable.
