WILD ROSE FOUNDATION AMENDMENT ACT, 1991

(Assented to , 1991)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Wild Rose Foundation Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 3 is repealed and the following is substituted:
 - 3 The purposes of the Foundation are as follows:
 - (a) to provide funding to volunteer non-profit organizations that provide valuable services to Albertans;
 - (b) to foster or promote the use of volunteers or to assist those who volunteer or use the services of volunteers in Alberta;
 - (c) to foster or promote charitable, philanthropic, humanitarian, public spirited or generous acts or to assist those who perform them.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter W-7.8 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1984.
- 2 Section 3 presently reads:
 - 3 The purpose of the Foundation is to provide funding to volunteer non-profit organizations that provide necessary and valuable community services to Albertans.
