TOBACCO TAX AMENDMENT ACT, 1991

, 1991)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Tobacco Tax Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 3(1) is amended
 - (a) in clause (a) by striking out "\$0.056" and substituting "\$0.07";
 - (b) by repealing clause (b) and substituting the following:
 - (b) on every cigar purchased by that consumer, 80% of the retail price of the cigar as determined before the inclusion of the tax imposed by this Act, with the tax payable on each cigar being not less than \$0.15 per cigar nor more than \$2.50 per cigar;
 - (c) in clause (c) by striking out "\$0.03" and substituting "\$0.04".
- 3 This Act is deemed to have come into force on April 5, 1991.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter T-5.1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1983.
- 2 Section 3(1) presently reads:
 - 3(1) Every consumer shall pay to Her Majesty in right of Alberta a tax computed at the following rates:
 - (a) on every cigarette purchased by that consumer, \$0.056;
 - (b) on every cigar purchased by that consumer, 70% of the retail price of the cigar as determined before the inclusion of the tax imposed by this Act, with the tax payable on each cigar being not less than \$0.12 per cigar nor more than \$2.00 per cigar;
 - (c) on every gram or part of a gram of any tobacco, other than cigarettes or cigars, purchased by that consumer, \$0.03.
