PENSION STATUTES (TRANSITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS) ACT, 1991

(Assented to , 1991)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Definition

- 1 In this Act, "pension statutes" means
 - (a) the Local Authorities Pension Plan Act,
 - (b) the Members of the Legislative Assembly Pension Plan Act.
 - (c) the Public Service Management Pension Plan Act,
 - (d) the Public Service Pension Plan Act,
 - (e) the Special Forces Pension Plan Act,
 - (f) the Teachers' Retirement Fund Act,
 - (g) the Universities Academic Pension Plan Act, and
 - (h) the Pension Fund Act.

Compliance with income tax rules

2 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations amending the pension statutes to the extent necessary to ensure that the pension plans under the pension statutes or the pension statutes themselves, following the amendments, comply with the rules in and under the *Income Tax Act* (Canada) applicable to registered pension plans and funds.

Provision for supplementary pension plans 3 Notwithstanding section 2, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may additionally by regulation amend the pension statutes described in section 1(b), (c) and (d), or any of them, to establish supplementary pension plans under those statutes that are not subject to the tax rules referred to in section 2, for those plan participants who are specified in the regulations.

Sunset provision

4 This Act has no force after August 31, 1992.
