AN ACT TO AMEND THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

(Assented to , 1991)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Legal Profession Act is amended by this Act.*
- 2 Section 93(2) is amended by adding the following after clause (e):*
 - (e.1) any person who appears as an agent for another person before a provincial judge in a proceeding pertaining to an offence under the Highway Traffic Act or Motor Vehicle Administration Act, unless such proceeding also pertains to an offence under an Act of the Parliament of Canada which does not expressly permit such representation pursuant to clause (f);**
- 3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation*

Explanatory Notes

1 This bill will amend chapter L-9 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980 to permit a person to be represented in traffic court by a paralegal or other non-lawyer representative.
