## AN ACT TO AMEND THE MARKETING OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS ACT

(Assented to

, 1991)

IHER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Marketing of Agricultural Products Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 16 is amended by repealing subsection (2).

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter M-5.1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1987.
- 2 Section 16(1) and (2) presently read:
  - 16(1) A plan shall not be established until
    - (a) the proposed plan is submitted to a plebiscite of the producers to determine whether the plan should be established, and
    - (b) the vote conducted under the plebiscite is in favour of the plan.
  - (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may exempt a proposed plan referred to in section 15(1)(d) from the requirement of being submitted to a plebiscite.

- 3 Section 18(1) is amended
  - (a) in clause (a) by repealing "or",
  - (b) by repealing clause (b).

- 3 Section 18(1) presently reads:
  - 18(1) Where
    - (a) a vote is in favour of the establishment of a plan referred to in section 15(1)(c) or (d), or
    - (b) a plan referred to in section 15(1)(d) is exempted from the requirement of being submitted to a plebiscite,

the Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations

- (c) establishing a plan setting forth provisions providing for
  - (i) initiating and carrying out projects or programs to commence, stimulate, increase or improve the production or marketing, or both, of an agricultural product,
  - (ii) the number of persons to be elected as members of the commission and the name of office by which those persons shall be known,
  - (iii) the method or methods by which the members of the commission shall be elected,
  - (iv) the method by which vacancies on the commission are to be filled, and
  - (v) the other terms referred to in section 15 under which the plan shall operate,

and

(d) establishing a commission to administer and operate a plan referred to in clause (a).
