AN ACT TO AMEND THE DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME ACT

(Assented to , 1991)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Daylight Saving Time Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 2 is amended by striking out "Mountain Standard Time" and substituting "Daylight Saving Time".
- 4 Section 4 is repealed.
- 3 Section 5 is repealed and the following substituted:
 - 5(1) Notwithstanding anything in any other Act, no municipality shall adopt, proclaim, enforce, use or observe any time other than Daylight Saving Time.
 - (2) A by-law passed or proclamation issued by the council or an official of a municipality providing for the adoption, proclamation, or enforcement of the use of observance of any time other than Daylight Saving Time is void.
- 5 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This bill will amend Chapter D-4 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta.
- 2 These amendments will replace Mountain Standard Time as the basic time standard relative to Greenwich Mean Time throughout Alberta for each entire year subsequent to Proclamation.
- 3 The regulatory and penalty provisions of the present statute remain unchanged.
