DAY OF MOURNING FOR INJURED WORKERS ACT

(Assented to , 1991)

WHEREAS the Legislative Assembly of Alberta recognizes the tragic sacrifices made by the thousands of Albertans who each year become victims of workplace injuries causing death or disability; and

WHEREAS it is appropriate that a solemn day of mourning be declared in honour of those who have been the victims of workplace injuries in Alberta;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 April 28 of each year is hereby declared to be a day of mourning in Alberta for workers killed or injured in the course of their employment.
- 2 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.
