CHARMAINE L. TOMS LEGAL ARTICLES ACT

(Assented to _____, 1991)

WHEREAS section 37(2) of the *Legal Profession Act* provides for articles to be served with a justice of certain courts, not including the Federal Court of Canada, Trial Division;

AND WHEREAS Charmaine L. Toms has served articles with the Federal Court of Canada, Trial Division, and the Law Society of Alberta has agreed that such articles are appropriate;

AND WHEREAS Charmaine L. Toms has by her petition prayed that it be enacted as herein set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Articles with
Federal Court of
Appeal

1(1) Notwithstanding section 37(2) of the *Legal Profession Act* of Alberta, the Benchers of the Law Society of Alberta permit Charmaine L. Toms, having received a degree in law and being admitted as a student-at-law under section 39(1) of the *Legal Profession Act*, to have served such part of her period under articles with Mr. Justice Bud Cullen of the Federal court of Canada, Trial Division.

(2) The Benchers may direct that the total period to be served under articles shall be such period exceeding 1 year as the Benchers prescribe.

2 In all other respects, the provisions of the *Legal Profession Act* governs Charmaine L. Toms' admission to the Alberta Bar.
