PUBLIC CONTRIBUTIONS AMENDMENT ACT, 1992

(Assented to

, 1992)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Public Contributions Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 18 is repealed and the following is substituted:
 - **18(1)** A city with a population exceeding 50 000 shall, and any other city may, by by-law designate any person or body as an approving authority for the purpose of this Act.
 - (2) A city may by by-law make rules, not inconsistent with this Act or the regulations, to give proper effect to this Act within the city.
- 3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter P-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 18 presently reads:

18 A city, by by-law, may designate any person or body as an approving authority for the purpose of this Act and may make rules, not inconsistent with this Act or the regulations, that may be necessary to give proper effect to this Act within the city.
