LANDLORD AND TENANT AMENDMENT ACT, 1992

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Landlord and Tenant Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 49(1) is repealed and the following is substituted:

Landlord and Tenant Advisory Boards

- **49(1)** The council of a city with a population exceeding 50 000 shall by by-law establish a Landlord and Tenant Advisory Board.
- (1.1) Any other council may by by-law establish a Landlord and Tenant Advisory Board.
- (1.2) A by-law under subsection (1) or (1.1) may provide for
 - (a) the remuneration of the members of the Board,
 - (b) matters pertaining to the Board's procedures, and
 - (c) matters incidental to the exercise of the Board's functions.
- 3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.
