LANDLORD AND TENANT AMENDMENT ACT, 1992

(Assented to _____, 1992)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 *The Landlord and Tenant Act is amended by this Act.*

2 *Section 49(1) is repealed and the following is substituted:*

49(1) The council of a city with a population exceeding 50 000 shall by by-law establish a Landlord and Tenant Advisory Board.

(1.1) Any other council may by by-law establish a Landlord and Tenant Advisory Board.

(1.2) A by-law under subsection (1) or (1.1) may provide for

- (a) the remuneration of the members of the Board,
- (b) matters pertaining to the Board's procedures, and
- (c) matters incidental to the exercise of the Board's functions.

3 *This Act comes into force on Proclamation.*

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter L-6 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

2 Section 49(1) presently reads:

49(1) A council may by by-law establish a Landlord and Tenant Advisory Board and provide for the remuneration of its members and any other matters pertaining to its procedures or incidental to the exercise of its functions.

3 Coming into force.
