ALBERTA LOCAL EMPLOYMENT TRANSFER ACT

(Assented to _____, 1992)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Definitions

1 In this Act;

- (a) “local government” means
 - (i) a council of a city, town, new town, village, summer village, municipal district, county or Metis Settlement,
 - (ii) a collecting board as defined in section 163 of the *School Act*, or
 - (iii) the Minister of Municipal Affairs in the case of a special area or an improvement district, other than an improvement district or that part of it situated in a national park;
- (b) “municipality” means a city, town, new town, village, summer village, municipal district, county, Metis Settlement, special area, improvement district or school district represented by a collecting board as defined in section 163 of the *School Act*.

Program

2(1) The Minister of Municipal Affairs shall pay to a local government an amount equal to

- (a) \$79.25 for each resident in the municipality, or

(b) \$17 500,

whichever is greater.

(2) The total of all amounts paid under subsection (1) shall not be more than \$200 000 000.

(3) The Minister of Municipal Affairs shall use the population figures for 1991 applicable to the calculation of a grant and determined by the Minister of Municipal Affairs under section 27 of the *Property Tax Reduction Act* as the basis for calculating the number of residents in a municipality.

3 All payments under this Act shall be made from the General Revenue Fund.
