#### MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

#### Preamble

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour, Gordon Towers, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenditures of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the fiscal years ending respectively March 31, 1992 and March 31, 1993, and for other purposes relating thereto:

MAY IT THEREFORE PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, as follows:

# Appropriation for 1991-92

1 From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding, in the whole, \$405 857 543 towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from April 1, 1991 to March 31, 1992, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule "A" to this Act.

# Appropriation for 1992-93

2 From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding, in the whole, \$11 677 481 014 towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from April 1, 1992 to March 31, 1993, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule "B" to this Act, including the amount of \$4 420 000 000 voted by section 1 of the Appropriation (Interim Supply) Act, 1992.

#### Accountability

**3** The due application of all money expended under this Act shall be accounted for.
