MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

Preamble

WHEREAS it appears by a Message from His Honour, Gordon Towers, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the Message, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenditures of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the fiscal year ending March 31, 1993, and for other purposes relating thereto:

MAY IT THEREFORE PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, as follows:

1 From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding, in the whole, \$402 779 101 towards defraying the further charges and expenses of the Public Service from April 1, 1992 to March 31, 1993, not otherwise provided for, being the total of the supplementary votes set forth in Schedule "A" to this Act and the special warrants set forth in Schedule "B" to this Act.

Accountability

2(1) The due application of all money expended under this Act shall be accounted for.

(2) The expenditures authorized by this Act may be made notwithstanding the *Spending Control Act*.
