## **BILL 204**

#### 1992

#### DANGEROUS DOGS AMENDMENT ACT

(Assented to , 1992)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Dangerous Dogs Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 The following is added before section 1:
  - 1 In this Act.
    - (a) "dangerous dog" means a dog listed in the schedule;
    - (b) "Minister" means the Member of the Executive Council charged by the Lieutenant Governor in Council with the administration of this Act;
  - 2 No person shall
    - (a) breed, or breed from, a dangerous dog;
    - (b) allow a dangerous dog to be in a public place unless it is muzzled and kept on a leash;
    - (c) allow a dangerous dog to stray; or
    - (d) allow a dangerous dog to be dangerously out of control in a public place.

# **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend Chapter D-3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta.
- 2 This amendment will restrict the breeding and movement of dangerous dogs and will impose substantial fines on owners and persons having control of dangerous dogs.

- 3 Dangerous dogs shall be kept in an enclosed area which is designed to prevent the dog from escaping or the public from gaining access.
- 4 Dangerous dogs shall be neutered.
- 3 Sections 1, 2 and 3 are amended by renumbering them as sections 5, 6, and 7 respectively.
- 4 The following is added after section 7:
  - 8 Every person who contravenes this Act is guilty of an offence and liable
    - (a) for a 1st offence, to a fine of not less than \$1000;
    - (b) for a 2nd and every subsequent offence, to a fine of not less than \$5000.
  - 9 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may, by order, amend the schedule by deleting therefrom or by adding thereto any breed or type of dog.
- 5 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

# SCHEDULE (Sections 1 and 9)

- 1 Any dog of the type known as the pit bull terrier.
- 2 Any dog of the type known as the rottweiler.
