LABOUR RELATIONS CODE AMENDMENT ACT

(Assented to , 1992)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Labour Relations Code is amended by this Act.

2 The following is added after section 128:

128.1 Notwithstanding anything in section 128, no employer
shall, except

(a) in accordance with an established custom or practice
of the employer, or

(b) with the consent of the bargaining agent,

alter the rates of pay, term or condition of employment or a
right or privilege of any employer represented by the
bargaining agent or of the bargaining agent itself.

3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend Chapter L-1.2 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta
2. This amendment will eliminate the severing effect that a 25 hour lockout has on collective agreement.
