MARKETING OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS AMENDMENT ACT

(Assented to , 1992)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Marketing of Agricultural Products Act is amended by this Act.
- 2. Section 26 is amended
 - (a) by renumbering it as section 26(1);
 - (b) by adding the following after subsection (1):
 - (2) Provided that a regulation made under this section shall only authorize the deduction of a charge, fee or levy from money payable to a producer if the producer has first consented, in writing, to the deduction being made.
- 3. This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill will amend Chapter M-5.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta.
- 2. This amendment will require boards or commissions established under the Act to have the consent of the producer before requiring any person, who receives a regulated product from a producer, to withhold any charges, fees or levies from money payable to the producer.
