LIVESTOCK AND LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS AMENDMENT ACT

(Assented to , 1992)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1 The Livestock and Livestock Products Act is Amended by this
Act.*

2 The following is added after section 6:

6.1 Notwithstanding anything in any other Act, title to and
property in livestock supplied to a dealer shall not be
transferred from the patron to the livestock dealer or any other
person until the patron has been paid in full.

6.2(1) No livestock dealer shall assign, mortgage, pledge or
otherwise charge any livestock in his possession unless and
until the owner of the livestock has been paid for the livestock.

(2) Any assignment, mortgage, pledge or charge made in
contravention of subsection (1) shall be of no force or effect.

3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Act will amend Chapter L-24 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta.**
- 2 This amendment will mean that title in livestock entrusted to a dealer for sale will not change hands until the livestock are paid for in full.**
- 3 Livestock dealers are prohibited from charging livestock which have not been paid for.**
