### **LABOUR RELATIONS CODE AMENDMENT ACT**

*(Assented to , 1992)*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1 The Labour Relations Code is amended by this Act.*

*2 The following is added after section 20:*

20.1 No person shall be required, as a condition of employment or continued employment,

(a) to resign or refrain from voluntary membership in, voluntary affiliation with, or voluntary financial support of a trade union;

(b) to become or remain a member of a trade union;

(c) to pay any dues, fees, assessments or other charges to a trade union or employer's organization;

(d) to pay any amount to any third party, in lieu of the payments referred to in subsection (c);

(e) to be recommended, referred, investigated or approved by a trade union or employer's organization.

20.2 No person shall intimidate or coerce or attempt to intimidate or coerce another person in order to compel that

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend Chapter L-1.2 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta.
- 2 This amendment will prohibit acts which would curtail, on the basis of association with either a trade union or employer's organization, the right of a person to work.
- 3 The use or attempted use of coercion to induce a person to participate or refrain from participating in either trade unions or employer's organizations is prohibited.

other person to join, affiliate with or financially support, or to refrain from so doing, a trade union or employer's organization.

*3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.*
