EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS CODE AMENDMENT ACT, 1992

(Assented to , 1992)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Employment Standards code is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 64(2) is amended by striking out "18 weeks" and substituting "26 weeks".
- 3 Section 70(2) is amended by striking out "8 weeks" and substituting "18 weeks".
- 4 Sections 2 and 3 applies only to those employees filing notice of their leave after this Act comes into force.
- 6 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter E 10.2 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1988.
- 2 This amendment would allow the extension of the present maternity leave by 8 weeks and the adoption leave by 10 weeks, continuing unemployment benefits coverage throughout. Provincial Legislation would be consistent with the Federal Unemployment Insurance Act (Canada).
