MEDICAL PROFESSION AMENDMENT ACT, 1993

(Assented to , 1993)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Medical Profession Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 The following is added after Section 34(2):
 - (3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), a matter, conduct or thing shall not, in the absence of demonstrable harm to the patient, be judged to be unbecoming conduct solely on the grounds that the matter, conduct or thing arises from a practice of chelation therapy.
- 3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend Chapter M-12 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 34(2) presently reads:
 - (2) Any manner, conduct or thing that in the judgment of the investigating committee, the council or the Court of Appeal, is such as to be inimical to the best interests of the public or profession, whether or not the act or conduct is disgraceful or dishonourable, is unbecoming conduct in the part if a registered practitioner.
