CALGARY MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTIES AUTHORITY AMENDMENT ACT, 1992

(Assented to , 1992)

WHEREAS the Calgary Municipal Heritage Properties Authority was established by chapter 55 of the Statutes of Alberta 1985; and

WHEREAS the Authority has presented a petition praying that the Act be amended as herein set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enact as follows:

1 The Calgary Municipal Heritage Properties Authority Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 4(b) is amended by adding the following at the end of it:

"to include, but not restricted to, holding and disbursing grant monies, whether or not held in trust and to act as an agent of any duly incorporated body in the disbursement of funds for that body."

3 Section 5 is struck and the following is substituted:

5 "The Authority shall comprise no less than 5 or more than 9 electors appointed by resolution of Council, up to 2 of whom may be members of Council".

4 Section 17 is amended in subsections (1) and (2) by replacing the word "shall" with the word "may".

Explanatory Notes

1. *Amends the Calgary Municipal Heritage Properties Authority Act.*
2. *This section clarifies the Authority's power with respect to grants and donations.*
3. *Changes composition of the Authority. The original section read*
 - 5 The Authority shall be composed of:
 - (a) 2 members of Council, appointed by resolution of Council,
 - (b) no less than 3 nor more than 7 electors appointed by resolution of Council.
- 4 *Changes compulsory direction to the Director of Finance and the Director of Land to permissive direction.*
