TEACHING PROFESSION AMENDMENT ACT, 1993

(Assented to , 1993)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Teaching Profession Act is amended by this Act.

2 The following is added after section 21:

21.1 The association shall not be designated as a bargaining agent within the meaning of the *Labour Relations Code*, nor shall it represent any teacher or group of teachers in any negotiation of a collective agreement.

3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend Chapter T-3 of the *Revised Statutes of Alberta*.
- 2 This amendment will prohibit the Association from acting as the bargaining agent of any teacher or group of teachers.
