OMBUDSMAN AMENDMENT ACT, 1993

, 1993)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Ombudsman Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 The following is added after Section 30(a):
 - (a.1) without lawful justification or excuse, evicts, discharges, suspends, expels, intimidates, coerces, imposes a pecuniary or other penalty on or otherwise discriminates against a person because that person has, in good faith, submitted a complaint to the Ombudsman or given evidence to or otherwise cooperated with an investigation under this Act,
- 3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend Chapter O-7 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta.
- 2 This amendment will protect persons who complain under the Act by forbidding the imposition of any penalty upon such a person.
