LIQUOR CONTROL AMENDMENT ACT, 1994

(Assented to , 1994)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Liquor Control Act is amended by this Act.*
- 2 Section 1 is amended*
 - (a) by repealing subsection (a) and substituting the following:*
 - (a) "adult" means a person who has attained the age of 19 years;*
 - (b) by repealing subsection (1)(l) and substituting the following:*
 - (l) "minor" means a person who has not attained the age of 19 years;*
- 3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.*

Explanatory Notes

1 Amends chapter L-17 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

2 Sections 1(a) and 1(l) presently read:

(a) "adult" means an adult within the meaning of the Age of Majority Act;

(l) "minor" means a minor within the meaning of the Age of Majority Act;
