LIQUOR CONTROL AMENDMENT ACT, 1994

(Assented to , 1994)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Liquor Control Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 1 is amended
 - (a) by repealing subsection (a) and substituting the following:
 - (a) "adult" means a person who has attained the age of 19 years;
 - (b) by repealing subsection (1)(l) and substituting the following:
 - (l) "minor" means a person who has not attained the age of 19 years;
- 3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.
