#### EDMONTON CHINATOWN MULTICULTURAL CENTRE FOUNDATION TAX EXEMPTION ACT

(Assented to , 1994)

WHEREAS the Edmonton Chinatown Multicultural Centre Foundation is an association formed under the *Societies Act* and is the occupant and leaseholder in possession of the lands hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS the objects of the Foundation are to promote multicultural understanding by contributing to a harmonious multicultural community by promoting cultural, educational and recreational activities; and

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Taxation exemption 1 The lands and improvements legally described as

Plan (D) Block Five (5) Lots 38 to 40 inclusive Edmonton (R.L. 12 & 14 EDM. SETT.) and

portion of the Main Floor and the Basement at Plan (D) Block Five (5) Lots 41 to 43 inclusive Edmonton (R.L. 12 & 14 EDM. SETT.)

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

shall be exempt from all municipal taxes and school taxes of every nature whatsoever, for so long as they remain the property or leasehold property of the Edmonton Chinatown Multicultural Centre Foundation, and are used for the fulfillment of its objects.
