## ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION STATUTES REPEAL ACT

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

#### Repeals

- 1 The following Acts are repealed:
  - (a) the Alberta Environmental Research Trust Act;
  - (b) the Environment Council Act;
  - (c) the Water Resources Commission Act.

#### Transitional

- 2(1) On the coming into force of section I(a),
  - (a) property of the Alberta Environmental Research Trus the form of money shall be transferred to Environmental Protection and Enhancement F established under the Environmental Protection Enhancement Act and outstanding funding commitment the Trust must be paid out of the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Fund,
  - (b) property of the Trust other than money becomes property of the Crown in right of Alberta under the s terms and conditions, and
  - (c) all assets owned by the Trust become assets of the Cr in right of Alberta.
- (2) Where the Crown disposes of property of the Trust referred in subsection (1)(b), the net proceeds of the disposition shappaid into the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Fu
- (3) On the coming into force of section 1(b) all of the assets liabilities of the Environment Council of Alberta become the a

and liabilities of the Crown in right of Alberta under the same terms and conditions.

(4) On the coming into force of section 1(c) all of the assets and liabilities of the Water Resources Commission become the assets and liabilities of the Crown in right of Alberta under the same terms and conditions.

## Consequential amendments

- 3(1) The Conflicts of Interest Act is amended in Part 3 of the Schedule by striking out "Environment Council of Alberta".
- (2) The Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act is amended by repealing section 7(1)(d).
- (3) The Wilderness Areas, Ecological Reserves and Natural Areas Act is amended by repealing section 4.
