LIVESTOCK AND LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1995

(Assented to , 1995)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Amends RSA 1 The Livestock and Livestock Products Act is amended by this 1980 cL-24 Act.

2(1) The following is added after section 6:

Title to and property in livestock **6.1(1)** In this section, "livestock" means a class or type of livestock prescribed by the regulations under subsection (4).

(2) Notwithstanding any other enactment or any contract, the title to and property in livestock delivered to a licensed livestock dealer by a patron remains in the patron and does not pass to the licensed livestock dealer or to any other person claiming through the dealer until the patron has been paid for the livestock.

(3) Notwithstanding any other enactment or any contract, an interest granted by a licensed livestock dealer in any livestock that secures payment or performance of an obligation does not attach to livestock delivered to the licensed livestock dealer by a patron until the patron has been paid for the livestock.

(4) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations prescribing the classes or types of livestock to which this section applies.

(2) Section 6.1 as enacted by subsection (1) applies to livestock delivered to a licensed livestock dealer after section 6.1 comes into force.

Explanatory Notes

1 Amends chapter L-24 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

2 Patrons must receive payment for livestock supplied to licensed livestock dealers before title and property in the livestock can pass and before the dealer can use the livestock as security for a loan.
