#### **FAMILY DAY AMENDMENT ACT, 1995**

(Assented to , 1995)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Family Day Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 1 is amended by striking out "Monday" and substituting "Sunday" and striking out "public holiday" and substituting "day of public celebration".
- 3 The Employment Standards Code is amended by repealing clause 1(1)(g)(i.1).

- 4 The Interpretation Act is amended in section 25(1)(i.1)(ii) by striking ", Alberta Family Day".
- 5 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 Amends chapter F-1.5 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1989.
- 2 Family Day is no longer a public holiday.
- 3 Section 1(1)(g) of the Employment Standards Code presently reads in part:
  - 1(1) In this Act,
    - (g) "general holiday" means
      - (i.1) Alberta Family Day,
- 4 Section 25(1) of the Interpretation Act presently reads in part:
  - 25(1) In an enactment,
    - (i.1) "holiday" includes
      - (ii) New Years's Day, Alberta Family Day,
