## COLIN CHOR WEE CHEW LEGAL ARTICLES ACT

(Assented to

, 1995)

WHEREAS Colin Chor Wee Chew is a permanent resident in Canada and has resided in Alberta since August 5, 1991, and intends to apply for Canadian citizenship as soon as he is qualified to do so, but is unable to be admitted to the bar and practise law in Alberta as he is unable to satisfy the requirements of section 42(1)(c) of the Legal Profession Act; and

WHEREAS Colin Chor Wee Chew completed his legal training in England and was called to the bar in England on November 25, 1969, and was called to the bar in Malaysia on July 20, 1972 and practised there subsequently and was additionally called to the bar in Australia on April 21, 1989; and

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying for the exemption of Colin Chor Wee Chew from the provisions of the Legal Profession Act requiring his active engagement in the practice of law in a specific jurisdiction for a specific period of time as set out in section 42(1)(c) of the said Act and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 Notwithstanding section 42(1)(c) of the Legal Profession Act, the Secretary of The Law Society of Alberta shall approve the admission of Colin Chor Wee Chew as a student-at-law under section 42(1) of that Act.

2 In all other respects, the provisions of the Legal Profession Act govern Colin Chor Wee Chew's admission as a student-at-law and his enrollment as a member of The Law Society of Alberta.
