CONCORDIA COLLEGE AMENDMENT ACT, 1995

(Assented to , 1995)

WHEREAS Concordia College was incorporated by An Act to Incorporate Concordia College, being chapter 76 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1978 as amended by chapter 48 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1994; and

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that the Act be further amended as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 An Act to Incorporate Concordia College is amended by this Act.
- 2 The title of the Act is struck out and the following is substituted:

CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE ACT

- 3 Section 1 is repealed and the following is substituted:
 - 1 This Act may be cited as the Concordia University College Act.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 Amends chapter 76 of the Statutes of Alberta 1978.
- 2 The title presently reads:

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE CONCORDIA COLLEGE

- 3 Section 1 presently reads:
 - 1 This Act may be cited as The Concordia College Act.

4 Section 2 is amended

- (a) by repealing clause (a) and substituting the following:
 - (a) "Board" means the Board of Regents of Concordia University College;
- (b) by repealing clause (b) and substituting the following:
 - (b) "Corporation" means the body corporate created by this Act under the name of Concordia University College;

5 Section 3 is amended

- (a) by repealing subsection (1) and substituting the following:
 - (1) All persons as are from time to time appointed to be members of the board are constituted and established a body corporate under the name of Concordia University College.
- (b) in subsection (2) by adding the following after clause (g):
 - (h) has the power to carry out all other acts or deeds for the fulfillment of its objects as are deemed necessary by the Board;
 - (i) has the power to change its name by by-law as may be approved by the Minister of Advanced Education and Career Development from time to time.
- 6 Section 4 is amended by adding the following after subsection (3):
 - (4) All of the property owned or occupied by the Corporation for the purposes of pursuing its objects shall be exempt from taxation under the *Municipal Government Act* insofar as the property of the Corporation is devoted to educational and charitable activities.

- 4 Section 2(a) and (b) presently read:
 - (a) "Board" means the Board of Regents of Concordia College;
 - (b) "Corporation" means the body corporate created by this Act under the name of Concordia College;

- 5 Section 3(1) presently reads:
 - 3(1) Paul Gerald Otke and George Rode, both of the City of Edmonton; Luther Edgar Schroeder of the City of Red Deer; Vernon Arthur Raaflaub of the City of Camrose; Robert Glen Guebert of the Town of Leduc and such other persons as are from time to time appointed to be members of the Board, as hereinafter provided, are hereby constituted and established a body corporate under the name of Concordia College.
