APPROPRIATION (SUPPLEMENTARY SUPPLY) ACT, 1997

(Assented to _____, 1997)

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

Preamble WHEREAS it appears by a Message from His Honour H. A. "Bud" Olson, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Supplementary Estimates accompanying the Message, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenditures of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the fiscal year ending March 31, 1997, and for other purposes relating thereto:

MAY IT THEREFORE PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, as follows:

Operating expense **1** From the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum of \$217 313 000, towards defraying the further charges and expenses of the Public Service classed as operating expense for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1997, not otherwise provided for, as shown in Schedule A and which was provided by supplementary supply special warrant as shown in Schedule B.

Capital investment **2** From the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum of \$5 600 000, towards defraying the further charges and expenses of the Public Service classed as capital investment for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1997, not otherwise provided for, as shown in Schedule A and which was provided by supplementary supply special warrant as shown in Schedule B.

Transfer **3** The member of the Executive Council designated as the Minister responsible for the *Gaming and Liquor Act* shall, pursuant to section 27 of the Act, transfer \$456 200 000 from the Lottery Fund to the General Revenue Fund in respect of the fiscal year ending March 31, 1997.

Accountability **4** The due application of all money expended under this Act shall be accounted for.
