HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Amends SA 1988 cS-3.1

- 1 The School Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 The following is added after section 22:

Private school funding

- 22.1(1) In this section, "amount per student" means the amount obtained when
 - (a) the total funds received by a school, pursuant to this Act or any other enactment, that are allocated to basic instruction,

are divided by

- (b) the number of students enrolled in the school.
- (2) The Minister shall calculate the amount per student to be paid, pursuant to this Act or any other enactment, to accredited private schools in such a way that the payment for a school year to an accredited private school is consistent with the principle that each accredited private school receives an amount per student that is not less than 75% of the amount per student received by a board.
