### **SCHOOL AMENDMENT ACT, 1997**

*(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1997)*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Amends SA  
1988 cS-3.1

**1 The *School Act* is amended by this Act.**

**2 The following is added after section 22:**

Private school  
funding

**22.1(1)** In this section, "amount per student" means the amount  
obtained when

(a) the total funds received by a school, pursuant to this  
Act or any other enactment, that are allocated to basic  
instruction,

are divided by

(b) the number of students enrolled in the school.

(2) The Minister shall calculate the amount per student to be  
paid, pursuant to this Act or any other enactment, to accredited  
private schools in such a way that the payment for a school year  
to an accredited private school is consistent with the principle  
that each accredited private school receives an amount per  
student that is not less than 75% of the amount per student  
received by a board.
