COST DECLARATION ACCOUNTABILITY ACT

(Assented to , 1997)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

| Definition | 1 In this Act, "public money" means public money as defined in the <i>Financial Administration Act</i> . |
| Program cost | 2 Where a program that will be funded by public money is to be implemented, the Minister of the Crown who will be responsible for the program shall, at the time of introducing the Bill in the Legislative Assembly that authorizes the program, if it is to be authorized by an Act, table a declaration of the estimated annual cost of the program in each of the first 3 years of its intended operation, expressed as a total cost and as a cost per capita for every resident of Alberta. |
| Effective date | 3 This Act applies in respect of programs to be implemented after the coming into force of this Act. |
| Coming into force | 4 This Act comes into force on Proclamation. |
