PHARMACEUTICAL PROFESSION AMENDMENT ACT, 1997

(Assented to , 1997)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Amends SA 1988 cP-7.1

1 The *Pharmaceutical Profession Act* is amended by this Act

2 The following is added after section 88:

Refuse to dispense

- 88.1(1) A pharmacist may refuse
 - (a) to dispense, or purchase for resale or otherwise carry in stock, a drug or class of drugs, or
 - (b) to counsel a patient

on the basis of the pharmacist's moral, ethical or religious beliefs.

(2) A pharmacist who, pursuant to subsection (1), refuses to dispense a drug to a patient or to counsel a patient shall advise the patient of the basis for the refusal so that the patient can consult another pharmacist.

Coming into force
