HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS AMENDMENT ACT, 1998

(Assented to , 1998)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Amends RSA 1980 cH-5

- 1 The *Health Insurance Premiums Act* is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 4 is repealed.

- 3 The Seniors Benefit Act is amended in section 6(g) by striking out "administering section 4 of that Act" and substituting "determining eligibility for premium subsidies for seniors".
- 4 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 Amends chapter H-5 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Section 4 presently reads:
 - 4(1) If a registrant or the registrant's spouse is receiving a benefit under the Seniors Benefit Act, the registrant is not liable for the payment of premiums on behalf of the registrant, the registrant's spouse or the registrant's dependants.
 - (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to premiums that have become due or become due during a period of time when the registrant or the registrant's spouse is not receiving a benefit under the Seniors Benefit Act.
- 3 Consequential amendment.
- 4 Coming into force.
