POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION STATUTES AMENDMENT ACT, 1998

(Assented to _____, 1998)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Colleges Act

Amends RSA
1980 cC-18

1(1) The *Colleges Act* is amended by this section.

**(2) Section 37 is amended by adding the following after
clause (d):**

- (e) prescribing the gross annual operating expenditures for
each college.

(3) The following is added after section 38.3:

Limit on tuition
fees

38.4(1) In this section, "gross annual operating expenditures"
means those total annual expenditures prescribed by the
Lieutenant Governor in Council as relating to the
management, administration and operation of a college.

Explanatory Notes

Colleges Act

- 1(1) Amends chapter C-18 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980.
- (2) Section 37 presently reads:
 - 37 *The Lieutenant Governor in Council may*
 - (a) *make regulations governing the conducting and operation of the college system;*
 - (b) *prescribe model by-laws for college boards;*
 - (c) *make necessary regulations or orders concerning any matters that arise and for which no provision is made in this or any other Act;*
 - (d) *make regulations respecting tuition fees and prescribing which fees constitute tuition fees.*
- (3) Limit on tuition fees.

(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the total amount of tuition fees prescribed by a college board, approved by the Minister or set by the Lieutenant Governor in Council must not exceed an amount that is equal to 20% of the gross annual operating expenditures of the college.

Technical Institutes Act

Amends SA
1981 cT-3.1

2(1) The *Technical Institutes Act* is amended by this section.

(2) Section 37.1 is repealed and the following substituted:

Regulations

37.1 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations

- (a) respecting tuition fees and prescribing which fees constitute tuition fees;
- (b) prescribing the gross annual operating expenditures for each technical institute.

(3) The following is added after section 37.1:

Limit on tuition
fees

37.2(1) In this section, "gross annual operating expenditures" means those total annual expenditures prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council as relating to the management, administration and operation of a technical institute.

(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the total amount of tuition fees prescribed by a board, approved by the Minister or set by the Lieutenant Governor in Council must not exceed an amount that is equal to 20% of the gross annual operating expenditures of the technical institute.

Universities Act

Amends RSA
1980 cU-5

3(1) The *Universities Act* is amended by this section.

(2) The following is added after section 68:

Limit on fees
for instruction

68.1(1) In this section, "gross annual operating expenditures" means those total annual expenditures prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council as relating to the

2(1) Amends chapter T-3.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1981.

(2) Regulations.

(3) Limit on tuition fees.

Universities Act

3(1) Amends chapter U-5 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980.

(2) Limit on fees for instruction.

(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the total amount of fees for instruction determined by a board, approved by the Minister or set by the Lieutenant Governor in Council must not exceed an amount that is equal to 20% of the gross annual operating expenditures of the university.

(3) Section 69 is amended by adding the following after clause (e):

(e.1) prescribing the gross annual operating expenditures for each university;

(3) Section 69 presently reads in part:

69 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations

(e) respecting fees for instruction and prescribing which fees constitute fees for instruction;
