## SCHOOL (PRINCIPAL'S DUTIES) AMENDMENT ACT, 1998

(Assented to , 1998)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

#### Amends SA 1988 cS-3.1

- 1 The School Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 15 is amended by renumbering it as section 15(1) and by adding the following after subsection (1):
  - (2) When a principal reasonably believes that a serious incident has occurred including
    - (a) physical violence,
    - (b) sexual assault,
    - (c) sexual abuse,
    - (d) vandalism,
    - (e) use or possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon, or
    - (f) use or possession of a narcotic

in the school or on school property, the principal shall notify the local police service and the superintendent of the serious incident as soon as practicable.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 Amends chapter S-3.1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1988.
- 2 Section 15 presently reads:
  - 15 A principal of a school must
    - (a) provide instructional leadership in the school;
    - (b) ensure that the instruction provided by the teachers employed in the school is consistent with the courses of study and education programs prescribed, approved or authorized pursuant to this Act;
    - (c) evaluate or provide for the evaluation of programs offered in the school;
    - (c.1) ensure that students in the school have the opportunity to meet the standards of education set by the Minister;
      - (d) direct the management of the school;
      - (e) maintain order and discipline in the school and on the school grounds and during activities sponsored or approved by the board;
      - (f) promote co-operation between the school and the community that it serves;

3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

- (g) supervise the evaluation and advancement of students;
- (h) evaluate the teachers employed in the school;
- (i) subject to any applicable collective agreement and the principal's contract of employment, carry out those duties that are assigned to the principal by the board in accordance with the regulations and the requirements of the school council and the board.
- 3 Coming into force.
