### SCHOOL (STUDENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT) AMENDMENT ACT, 2000

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1 The *School Act* is amended by this Act.**

**2 The following is added after section 44:**

Board policy  
regarding  
student  
conduct

**44.1(1)** A board shall develop and implement a written policy respecting student conduct which addresses the following activities in the school and on the school grounds and during activities sponsored or approved by the board:

- (a) physical violence;
- (b) sexual assault;
- (c) sexual abuse;
- (d) vandalism;
- (e) the use or possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon;
- (f) the use or possession of a narcotic;
- (g) the use or possession of alcohol or tobacco.

**(2)** In developing a policy under subsection (1), a board shall solicit and give due consideration to input received from

parents, students, teachers and principals.

(3) A policy established under subsection (1) shall provide counselling for students where appropriate.

(4) A policy established under subsection (1) shall include penalty options which enable students to continue pursuing their studies.
