POLICE (SPECIAL CONSTABLE SAFETY) AMENDMENT ACT, 2000

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The *Police Act* is amended by this Act.

2 The following is added after section 42:

Special
constable
safety

42.1 The Minister shall authorize a special constable employed by a municipality to have a restricted weapon in his possession during the time that he is engaged in carrying out his duties if

- (a) the municipality determines that there is a concern for the personal safety of the special constable while he is carrying out his duties,
- (b) the municipality passes a resolution recommending to the Minister that a special constable employed by that municipality be authorized to carry a restricted weapon while he is carrying out his duties, and
- (c) the special constable has fulfilled the training requirements and met the necessary standards required for a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to carry a restricted weapon.

3 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.
