## SCHOOL (CLASS SIZE TARGETS)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The School Act is amended by this Act.

## 2 The following is added after section 16:

16.1(1) In this section, "class" means a group of
(a) students, or
(b) children in an early childhood services program
who are scheduled to report regularly at a particular time to a particular teacher.
(2) Subject to subsection (3), the following targets for maximum class sizes must be applied by a board:
(a) 17 children in any early childhood services program class offered by or for a board under section 24 ,
(b) 17 students in any class for grades 1 to 3,
(c) 25 students in any class for grades 4 to 9 ,
(d) 30 students in any class for grades 10 to 12 .

## Explanatory Notes

1 Amends chapter S-3.1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1988.

2 Class size targets.
(3) Where a school demonstrates to the board that there are compelling reasons for not complying with the maximum class size targets in subsection (2), the board may grant a waiver with any terms and conditions it deems appropriate.
(4) Any waiver granted by a board under subsection (3) must be
(a) made public, and
(b) provided to the Minister.

Coming into force

3 This Act comes into force on September 1, 2002.
