WESTERN UNION INSURANCE COMPANY AMENDMENT ACT, 2001

(Assented to _____, 2001)

WHEREAS Western Union Insurance Company was incorporated by *An Act to Incorporate the Western Union Insurance Company*, chapter 34 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1940, which was amended by chapter 71 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1942, chapter 74 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956, and chapter 84 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1979;

WHEREAS Western Union Insurance Company changed its name to ING Western Union Insurance Company and in French to ING Western Union Compagnie d'assurance pursuant to Order in Council numbered O. C. 291/2000;

WHEREAS ING Western Union Insurance Company is seeking an amendment to authorize an application to continue as a company under the *Insurance Companies Act* (Canada); and

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that the Act be further amended as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 *An Act to Incorporate the Western Union Insurance Company* is amended by this Act.

2 The title to the Act is struck out and the following is substituted:

3 The following is added after section 9:

Continuance
out of Alberta

9.1 Sections 147 to 150 of the *Insurance Act*, S.A. 1999, c. I-5.1 shall apply to the company.
