EMBLEMS OF ALBERTA (OFFICIAL GEMSTONE) AMENDMENT ACT, 2004

(Assented to , 2004)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Amends RSA 2000 cE-6

- 1** The *Emblems of Alberta Act* is amended by this Act.

- 2** Section 1(b) is amended by adding the following after subclause (xi):
 - (xii) the official gemstone of Alberta.

3 The following is added after section 11:

Gemstone of Alberta

Official gemstone

11.1 The gemstone known as ammolite is hereby adopted as the official gemstone of Alberta.

4 This Act comes into force on Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

1 Amends chapter E-6 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000.

2 Section 1 presently reads in part:

1 In this Act,

(b) “official emblem” means

(i) the armorial bearings of Alberta;

(ii) the Flag of Alberta;

(iii) the floral emblem of Alberta;

(iii.1) the official grass of Alberta;

(iv) the Alberta Tartan;

(v) the Alberta Dress Tartan;

(vi) the official bird of Alberta;

(vii) the official stone of Alberta;

(viii) the official tree of Alberta;

(ix) *the official colours of Alberta;*

(x) *the official mammal of Alberta;*

(xi) *the official fish of Alberta.*

3 Designation of ammolite as official gemstone of Alberta.
