TRAFFIC SAFETY (MANDATORY MOTORCYCLE TRAINING) AMENDMENT ACT, 2006

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Amends RSA 2000 cT-6

1 The *Traffic Safety Act* is amended by this Act.

2 The following is added after section 55:

Mandatory motorcycle training

55.1(1) In this section, “Class 6 operator’s licence” means a licence of the type described in section 26 of the *Operator Licensing and Vehicle Control Regulation* (AR 320/2002).

(2) A person who applies for a Class 6 operator’s licence on or after July 1, 2007, shall provide the Registrar, in a form and manner acceptable to the Registrar, with proof confirming that the applicant has successfully completed a certified training course.

3 Section 64 is amended by adding the following after clause (c):

(c.1) governing the certification of training courses for the purposes of section 55.1;

4 This Act comes into force on July 1, 2007.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 Amends chapter T-6 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000.
- 2 Introduction of course requirement for Class 6 operator's licence.

- 3 Section 64 presently reads in part:

64 The Minister may make regulations

- (c) *governing any matter with respect to the operation of driving schools and driving courses and the teaching or instructing of persons to operate vehicles and the provision of insurance in respect of those matters;*

4 Coming into force.
